Market in the Park is a one day garden sale hosted by the Master Gardener Volunteers of Cornell Cooperative Extension of Monroe County. **On Saturday May 25**th, the public is invited to the historic Warner Castle grounds in Highland Park to shop for plants and garden related items.

It is a full morning of garden interest. Participating growers and vendors will be offering a variety of unique perennials, annuals, succulents, herbs, vegetables, shrubs, trees and garden art. Master Gardeners will be on site with their "Ask a Master Gardener" booth to answer questions. Additionally, they will be offering tours of the Warner Castle Gardens. Ongoing short talks on garden topics will round out the morning.

Warner Castle is located at the corner of Mt. Hope and Reservoir Avenue, a unique part of Highland Park in Rochester, N.Y. 14620. This is the second year Master Gardeners have sponsored this event at the historic Warner Castle. Monroe County Parks have graciously allowed Cornell Cooperative Extension of Monroe County to present this gardening event to the public. The event is free and open to the public.

Master Gardeners engage with the public in a multitude of ways. You can find them at community gardens, farmers' markets, school gardens, local fairs, local parks and nature centers.
