### **VIRTUAL 4-H DAIRY JUDGING WORKSHOP SERIES**

Since we can't get you all together to dairy judge, we are bringing it to your living room! Join Dr. Doug Waterman, Kevin Ziemba and Casey Hinz for a workshop series that teaches you the ideas and concepts of dairy judging across the breeds. Regardless, if you are new to dairy judging or a seasoned judge, these workshops will give you the opportunity to grow as a dairy judge, connect with your fellow dairy judgers (via Zoom), and build mastery in your dairy judging skills. Open to all NYS 4-H members, parents, coaches and 4-H Educators.

Join us for four sessions with the first session is will include the how to's and what to look for when judging dairy cattle. Sessions two, three and four you will be practicing judging cattle followed by analyzing them together.
