What you'll need: 1 1/2 cups white whole wheat flour, 1/4 cup rolled oats, 1 teaspoon baking powder, 1 large egg, 3/4 cup milk (1% or fat free), 1 cup peanut butter (natural no sugar or salt added), baking sheet, mixing bowl, spoon or wisk, and parchment paper. Optional: cookie cutters.
