Garden in a Bucket! Monroe County 4-H Mighty Mondays go Virtual with May Container Garden Workshop

Flowers are blooming, birds are chirping, and outside temperatures are finally warming up, spring has arrived in upstate New York. What better way to celebrate the arrival of spring than by planting your own garden in a bucket!

Monroe County 4-H is offering "Garden in a Bucket," an online container garden workshop on Monday, May 18 from 6 - 7 p.m. This workshop will explore general plant needs, how to create and take care of a container garden, and will include a plant trivia game. Prior to the workshop, participants in Monroe County* will receive a garden in a bucket kit containing plants and planting material. Participants will get to choose between creating an herb or flower garden. The goal of the workshop is to get our hands dirty, find some distraction, have fun, and get excited about plants.

There is a \$15 materials fee to participate in the workshop; this fee includes all you need to grow a mini herb or flower garden (minus water) and a no contact drop-off of materials at your home by Monroe County 4-H staff. The workshop will be limited to the first 12 registrants that sign up. The registration deadline is Monday, May 11.
