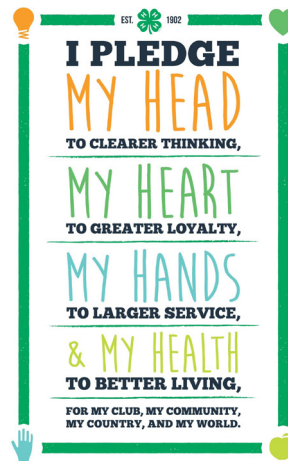

A Walk Through the Pumpkin Patch

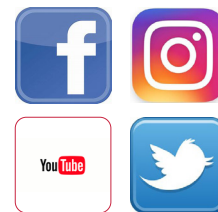
Join us as we head into the virtual pumpkin patch, and learn all about this quintessential fall fruit! Participants will follow along and make a delicious treat to enjoy at home!
