4-H Mighty Monday: **CHOCOLATE CREATIONS**







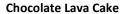


MONDAY, FEBRUARY 8 | 6 – 7 P.M.

To participate in the hands-on activities at home, families will need:

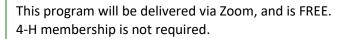


(makes 1 mug cake):

- 1/2 teaspoon baking powder
- Pinch of salt
- 1 egg
- 3 tablespoons milk
- 3 tablespoons melted butter
- 1 tablespoon water
- 1 oz chocolate chips

Hot Chocolate Mix:

- mixing bowl
- sealed container or bag for storage
- 3 cups powdered sugar
- 2 cups instant chocolate milk mix
- 1 ½ cups instant dry milk
- 1 large box (4.6 ounces) instant chocolate pudding mix
