

**MONROE COUNTY 4-H
REQUIREMENTS TO QUALIFY FOR REGIONAL/STATE HORSE EDUCATIONAL EVENTS**

In the interest of providing a well-rounded 4-H experience to the members of the 4-H Horse Program, the following requirements should be met by 4-H members hoping to qualify for Regional and State Horse Educational Events (Horse Bowl, Horse Judging, Public Presentations, Hippology.) As the requirements are fulfilled, the 4-H member is responsible for obtaining the signature of the organizer of each event.

A. Attend a minimum of 50% of scheduled practices for your knowledge event. Horse Bowl practices count toward Hippology qualification.
