



Cloverbud Presenters



Cloverbuds present a **Show & Tell** style presentation that should be between 1–3 minutes. It's good to follow the format of other kinds of presentations, so try to include:



AN INTRODUCTION— Make it fun and exciting

A BODY— Tell us all about your topic

A CONCLUSION— Sum it all up in a sentence or two

When you are finished, be prepared to answer some questions from the audience.

It's good to practice restating the question, "The question was ..."

EVALUATION FOR CLOVERBUDS

It's all about participation and encouragement at this level. Each Cloverbud participant will meet with a Cloverbud Specialist after his/her presentation. The Specialist will celebrate the Cloverbud's accomplishment using the Cloverbud Comment Sheet, which includes:

- 1) I really liked the way you ...
- 2) Thank you for sharing with me...
- 3) I would like to share this tip with you...
