Ready to Apply?

- Use the above URL and click the "Volunteer with 4-H" link to find the volunteer application. <http://monroe.cce.cornell.edu/4-h-youth-development/volunteer-with-4-h>
- Complete the volunteer application then:
 - email it to monroe4H@cornell.edu or
 - Mail it to the address at top right or
 - Drop it off at the 4-H office at above address



Let's Get Started!

- Once you've become acquainted with 4-H staff, you will then schedule an informal interview and orientation

Gather & Excite!

- Conduct an informational meeting to excite youth and their families about 4-H
- Build interest and commitment

(To establish a club, you will need at least five youth (ages 5-18) from 3 or more families & another adult leader willing to help.)

Meet & Plan!

- Decide on a club name and an area of focus that represents your interests. If you can't decide on a single interest or don't know where to start, 4-H staff can help you pick one, or you may consider starting a general club
- Establish meeting dates and times
- Discuss working agreements

Enroll!

- Contact our office using the information at the bottom of the page to complete a member enrollment, then complete each member's enrollment paperwork and collect dues

(\$20 per year per member with a family max of \$50. Membership dues waived for youth receiving free school lunch.)

Grow!

- Develop your club with youth officers and a club plan. Complete the club charter - we will help!
